- Clean upholstery, rugs, and other surfaces, using cleaning agents, applicators, and cleaning devices.
- Apply revitalizers and preservation agents to vinyl or leather surfaces and treat fabrics with spot- and stain-resistant chemicals to preserve and protect interior components.
- Clean engine and engine compartment with steam-cleaning equipment and/or pressure washer and various cleaning agents to remove grease and grime.
- Apply special-purpose cleaners to remove foreign materials that standard cleaning procedures do not remove, utilizing experience and judgment and following recommendations of the product's manufacturer.
- Paint engine components and related parts, using spray gun or aerosol can and masking materials.
- Apply paint to chipped body surfaces of vehicles, using touch-up paint.
- Apply dyes and reconditioning chemicals when necessary.
- Inspect and finalize vehicles ensuring client satisfaction
- Maintaining the proper function of all service tools and equipment.
- Coordinating work with team members in a synchronized manner.
- Transportation of customer and company vehicles on and off property
- General shop maintenance and daily housekeeping, restroom and office areas
- Other duties as assigned (include and not limited to cutting grass, painting, updating signs, etc)
